

Bring your eye and ear protection, if you have them. Otherwise, they will be provided. Prescription glasses or sunglasses may generally be used as eye protection.

Dress appropriately for the weather conditions. You may wish to bring a hat or ball-cap for the live fire (outdoors). Wear comfortable pants, and wear some old comfortable shoes (for the dirt range). Avoid wearing shorts, tank tops or low cut shirts. The spent (and warm) brass tends to find the way to exposed, sensitive skin areas.

The location of the classroom training facility is: 605 G Street #120, Lincoln, CA 95648.

We will begin at the training facility, and drive to the outdoor range for live fire (just about 5 minutes north of the classroom). Please dress accordingly for the weather. You may wish to bring some bottled water. If you have a comfortable folding chair, bring that as well. The range can be a bit dusty at times.

The training facility is located at the corner of Hwy 65 (also known as G Street) and 6th street, on the north-east corner, directly across the street from the car wash. The entrance faces Hwy 65, and is 2 doors down from Dillian's Bar & Grill (in the Lincoln Plaza building). There is a clock tower on the top of the structure.

There is plenty of free parking available. You may park in the City parking lot, which is located at the corner of 6th and F streets, or there may be on street parking available as well.

There are plenty of restaurants nearby, including Subway, Mr. Pickles, deli's, Mexican food, Panda Express, McDonald's, Burger King, a Bar & Grill, and some great sit down Diner's within walking distance.

My Basic Pistol course includes the following: Use of a 22 caliber rim-fire semi- automatic pistol, ammunition, target, and training materials.

If you wish to bring your own firearm(s) for the outdoor course, and it is larger than 22 caliber rim-fire, you must bring your own ammunition. In the event that you need to reschedule, please give as much notice as possible, and refer to the class schedule on my website at www.BestHandgunTraining.com .

If you do bring a firearm to any course, be sure it is UNLOADED and in a locked container (ammunition stored separately). **Do NOT bring a firearm into the class until instructed to do so.**
